ABSTRACT SUBMISSION:

2. Abstracts should be data oriented reflecting the major findings of the paper
3. All abstracts will be reviewed by panel of experts and will be selected for oral/poster presentation
4. At least one author should register by paying the required registration fee. Only registered participant(s) will be allowed to attend the Seminar

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS:

Any author can send more than one abstracts single/jointly. Abstracts must all be submitted in English. The number of abstracts per presenting author is limited to one in each theme. The abstracts should not be more than 500 words and should be in Times New Roman.

The following information may kindly be noted while preparing the abstract:

1. Title should be centered aligned (Font Size – 14)
2. Name of the author(s) address including contact no. & email should be centered in bold & italic (Font size 12)
3. Keywords (3 – 4) avoiding duplication with the title.
4. The abstract should include Introduction, Materials & Methodology, Result & Discussion and Conclusion.
